

ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Calais find that it is necessary for the protection of public health, safety and welfare to make certain rules regarding use of the Curtis Pond Recreation Area; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Calais further find that such rules will ensure the public's use and enjoyment of the Curtis Pond Recreation Area;

It is hereby enacted, pursuant to 24 V.S.A., Chapter 59, that:

1. The Curtis Pond Recreation Area shall be open for use by the public between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 9:30 p.m. and closed to public use between the hours of 9:30 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.
2. No fires, camping or cutting of trees shall be allowed within the Curtis Pond Recreation Area.
3. No glass containers, alcoholic beverages, motor vehicles, dogs or horses shall be allowed within the Curtis Pond Recreation Area.
4. Members of the public using the Curtis Pond Recreation Area shall comply with all requests and instructions regarding such usage as may be made by the Town Officials, on-duty lifeguard and swimming instructors.
5. No littering, vandalism, destruction, or defacement of property shall be allowed within the Curtis Pond Recreation Area.
6. Any violation of the terms of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor. Any person convicted of a violation shall be subjected to a fine, not to exceed \$500, or imprisonment for a term not to exceed one year.
