

TOWN HIGHWAY #63 PARKING ORDINANCE

Pursuant to authority vested in the Town of Calais and its selectmen by 23 V.S.A. §1753 and 24 V.S.A. §§2291, 1971 and 1974, the following ordinance is hereby adopted and enacted by the Town of Calais:

Parking of motor vehicles within the right of way limits of Town Highway #63 (Memorial Hall Road, so-called) is hereby prohibited at all times.

Motor vehicles parked within such limits shall be towed. Reasonable towing charges together with storage charges at the rate of \$ 10.00 per day shall constitute a lien against the vehicle and/or its owner, which the owner thereof shall be required to pay.

Violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor. Anyone found to violate this ordinance, either as the owner or operator of a vehicle parked in violation hereof, may be fined no more than \$ 500.00.
