

## Town of Calais Wi-Fi Policy

It is the policy of the Town of Calais to provide access to the internet service to the public via Wi-Fi under the following conditions:

- ✦ The Town of Calais computer systems used for town business will be protected from unauthorized access.
- ✦ The public Wi-Fi network will be isolated(segmented) from the network used for Town business.
- ✦ The public Wi-Fi network will be available to the public via monitoring hardware and software (such as Cisco Meraki.) A user of the public wifi network will get access to the internet by clicking through an introductory screen and agreeing to be a responsible user.

The foregoing Policy was adopted by the selectboard of the Town of Calais, Vermont, this 27<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2015 and is effective as of this date until amended or repealed.
