

Town Meeting Day is Tuesday, March 6, 2018, at the Calais Elementary School, with polls open at 7am and closed at 7pm. The town and school warnings, sample ballots, and voter checklists are posted at the Town Office, the Maple Corner Store, and East Calais Store. All election and Town Meeting information is on the town website: www.calaisvermont.gov

To request Absentee Ballots, contact the town office and ballots will be mailed. (You can also request absentee ballots for the August 2018 Primary and November 2018 General Election. Absentee ballot requests must be renewed each year.)

You can vote early for the Town Meeting election during Town Office hours, Monday through Thursday 8 - 4 pm.

For the Town Meeting election, there are three ballots: Calais Town and School Officers (Blue), Calais Elementary Budget (Yellow) and U-32 Middle and High School Budget and Clerk/Treasurer (Salmon).

Town Meeting Day begins with the Calais School Meeting at 8am followed by the Town Meeting at 9:30am. Lunch will be sponsored by Historic Kents Corner, with proceeds supporting the Town Hall.
