

RESOLUTION

Proposed

Whereas under the authority granted to it pursuant to 24 V.S.A. Section 872, the Town of Calais Selectboard has the general supervision of the affairs of the town and shall cause to be performed all duties required of towns not committed by law to the care of any particular officer and therefore has the authority to create necessary committees, commissions, or boards.

Now, therefore, it is resolved by the Selectboard of the Town of Calais:

That there is established for the Town of Calais, effective (DATE), an Ordinance Advisory Committee which shall consist of (FIVE/SEVEN) members (AND X ALTERNATES?) for the purposes of reviewing and drafting amendments to existing Calais ordinances and suggesting new ordinances, and be it further

Resolved: That the members (and alternates) of the Ordinance Advisory Committee shall serve for a term of one year, and be it further

Resolved: That the Ordinance Advisory Committee will hold its meetings publicly and, at minimum, on a monthly basis to conduct the business requested by the Selectboard, and be it further

Resolved: That upon completion of review of all ordinances and all other related tasks set forth by the Selectboard, the Ordinance Advisory Committee shall cease to exist.
