- 1.) Public Comment - None
- 2.) Executive session for purpose of discussing real estate matter; no action taken
- 3.) August Minutes – Approved unanimously
- 4.) Conservation Fund Balance – \$74, 655.17 as of August 31, 2015
- 5.) Report from Aquatic Resources work group
 - a. Calais Lakes & Streams has been distributing informational material to new owners post property transfer
 - b. Group has been discussing with Ann Smith of Friends of the Winooski about contacting property owners on the Kingsbury Branch regarding stream bank restoration. Ann sent Julie names of the property owners.
 - c. Need additional information; ACTION ITEM – Julie to follow up with Ann
 - d. ACTION ITEM – Drew to contact the Eckhaus family about providing possible testimonial about the process
- 6.) Fall Foliage Bike/Hike/Paddle
 - a. Centennial year of establishing town forests
 - b. Event being led by and registration handled by Vermont Urban & Community Forestry Program
 - c. Event on October 3rd, 9:30 am to approximately 1:30
 - d. Starting at Robinson Saw Mill, 10-12 miles includes stops and lunch at Adamant Store

- 8.) Legare Farm – Jon Ramsay from the Vermont Land Trust and Pete Johnson will be at the 9/14 meeting of the Selectboard to discuss the Land Trust's purchase of the former Legare Farm now owned by Pete Johnson.

9.) Roads Advisory Committee update

- a. The road crew said they need more space between trees for plowing and clearing snow on Adamant Road between Lightening Ridge and Singleton Road. As a pilot project, members of the Roads Committee and Neal the Tree Warden walked the road identifying trees that can be cut and will be meeting with Toby and Alfred to review this.
