TUESDAY, MARCH 1, 2022

INFORMATIONAL HEARING: February 19, 2022, 10:00 a.m. via Zoom

An online Public Informational Hearing will take place on Saturday, February 19th at 10 am. Voters can ask questions and get information about Articles on the ballot. The hearing will be held in a hybrid format, with the option to attend via Zoom or in person at the Calais Town Hall, 1662 Kent Hill Road, Gospel Hollow. Masks are required.

TOWN MEETING DAY: Out an abundance of caution town meeting will take place by Australian Ballot.

AUSTRALIAN BALLOT: Tuesday March 1, 2022, at Calais Elementary School.

Polls are open from 7a.m. to 7p.m.

Location: Calais Elementary School, 321 Lightning Ridge Road. Mask Required.

CHECKLIST POSTED: The current checklist is attached to this posting. Please make sure your name is on it if you are a resident. If not, please register to vote.

VOTER REGISTRATION: You may register to vote in the upcoming Town Meeting at the Town Office during regular business hours, 8 a.m.- 4 p.m. or online at <https://MVP.sec.state.vt.us/>. Same day registration at the polls is available.

EARLY AND MAIL-IN VOTING

Ballots have been mailed to every active registered voter. If you do not receive your ballot by February 15th please contact the Town Clerk's Office to get a replacement ballot. The Calais Town Office encourages early and mail-in voting prior to election day. There will be no voting taking place at the Town Office. The Town Office will be closed on Town Meeting Day.

Early and Mail-In Voting: Mail or deliver your completed ballots to the Calais Town Office, 3120 Pekin Brook Road, East Calais, 05650 **prior** to election day.

If Mailing: Mail no later than February 21, 2022, to ensure timely delivery.

If Delivering in Person: Drop your completed ballots in the secure drobox located in the enclosed Town Office entrance by midnight February 28, 2022.

ON TOWN MEETING DAY: 7a.m. -7 p.m. You can submit your sealed ballots at the Calais Elementary School, 321 Lightning Ridge Road before the polls close at 7 p.m. Masks required; COVID-19 protocols apply.
