

TOWN OF CALAIS
SNOW REMOVAL AND PARKING ORDINANCE

Pursuant to authority vested in the Town of Calais and its Selectmen pursuant to 23 V.S.A. §1753 and 24 V.S.A. §2291, 1971 and 1974, the following ordinance is hereby adopted and enacted by the Town of Calais:

- 1) Parking of motor vehicles on the public highways of the Town of Calais between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 7 a.m. is hereby prohibited between November 1 and April 1 of each year.
- 2) Parking of motor vehicles on TH #67 (Church Street) between its junctions with Vermont Route 14 and State Aid Highway #4 (Marshfield Road) is hereby prohibited at all times except on Sundays between 8 a.m. and 12 noon.
- 3) Parking of motor vehicles on the southerly side of State Aid Highway #2 (Worcester Road) from its junction with West County Road to 255 Worcester Road is hereby prohibited at all times. This is the road from which the Curtis Pond swim area is accessed.
- 4) Motor vehicles parked on the public highways of the Town of Calais in violation of the above prohibitions shall be towed. The vehicle owner will be required to pay towing and storage charges.
- 5) No person, partnership or corporation shall throw, deposit or cause to be thrown, shoveled, propelled or deposited snow or ice from private property onto the travelled portion of any public highways.
- 6) Anyone found to violate this ordinance may be fined no more than \$50.00. This ordinance shall replace the Parking and Snow Removal Ordinance dated June 30, 1997.
