


ORDINANCE

The Board of Selectmen of the Town of Calais hereby ordains:  
Pursuant to Vermont Statutes, and in compliance with 24 V.S.A. 1972,  
the speed limit on Route 14 through the Town of Calais shall be 50  
miles per hour, with the exception of the posted portion through East  
Calais Village at 35 miles per hour, as established by the Vermont  
Agency of Transportation. Effective date of this ordinance is 60  
days from today.

Per Vermont Statutes Annotated, voters may petition for a vote on the  
question of disapproving this ordinance. Such petition must be  
signed by at least 5% of the Calais registered voters and the petition  
must be presented to the Selectmen and the Town Clerk within forty-four  
days of the adoption of this ordinance by the Selectmen. If a petition  
is received, the legislative body shall call a special Town Meeting  
within sixty days from receipt of the petition to decide on the issue.  
If no petition is received, this ordinance will become effective on  
October 10, 2003.

As required by law, a summary of this ordinance is being published in the  
Times Argus on August 20, 2003.

Note: By adopting the Vermont Agency of Transportation's speed limits  
on Route 14, the Town of Calais will be able to receive a portion of the  
traffic fines generated by tickets issued by the Sheriff's Department.  
Presently all the funds go to the State. The Town of Calais does not  
have the authority to change the State's established speed limits on  
Route 14.
