Dog Licensing

Per state law, it is every dog owner's responsibility to register your dog(s) in the town in which they live, no later than April 1st each year (\$4 late fee). The owner of any unlicensed dog that is picked up or requires action by an Animal Control Officer will incur a fine for non-registration.

To license your dog(s), mail or drop off your dog's current rabies certificate, along with payment to the Town of Calais. Fees are: \$9 for each spayed/neutered dog; \$13 for each intact dog. Licenses and dog tags will be mailed to you.
